#### FROM OUR DIOCESAN SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

RESPONSE TO WITNESS TALK – DIOCESAN ULTREYA – 2nd November, 2019

Thank you Gary, and thank you to your wife for dragging you along to Church and sending you to Cursillo.

Psalm 46 is a wonderful psalm. I looked it up in the Passion Translation of the Bible and it was headed up as 'GOD ON OUR SIDE'. That's always a good start.

Allow me to share the first 3 verses from this translation:

<sup>1</sup>God, you're such a safe and powerful place to find refuge! You're a proven help in time of trouble—*more than enough* and always available whenever I need you. <sup>2</sup>So we will never fear even if every structure of support were to crumble away. We will not fear even when the earth quakes and shakes, moving mountains and casting them into the sea. <sup>3</sup>For the raging roar of stormy winds and crashing waves cannot erode our faith in you.

Then we are told to 'Pause in his presence.'

How comforting and re-assuring are these words? Words that have led you, Gary into a deeper relationship with our LORD and Saviour. When your kidneys began to fail it was your faith that pulled you through – it was one of those times in your life that is described in no better way than in the Footprints prayer.

The Lord replied, "My precious, precious child. I love you, and I would never, never leave you during your times of trial and suffering. When you saw only one set of footprints, it was then that I carried you."

You trusted GOD to find you a new kidney and He did. You needed to touch the hem of JESUS' garment in the same way as the woman in **Matthew 9:20** did: Again, from the Passion Translation:

<sup>20</sup> Suddenly, a woman came from behind Jesus and touched the tassel of his prayer shawl *for healing*. She had been suffering from continual bleeding for twelve years (and here's the important bit) but had faith that Jesus could heal her. <sup>21</sup> For she kept saying to herself, "If I could only touch his prayer shawl I would be healed." <sup>22</sup> Just then Jesus turned around and looked at her and said, "My daughter, be encouraged. Your faith has healed you." And instantly she was healed!

Gary, you told us: "That morning, GOD told you to trust Him with all your heart, mind and soul. Nothing else matters – and – to love your neighbour as yourself." Thank you. You certainly have a faith relationship with your kidney specialist these days.

You also are aware that we all need to continue to work on our relationship with JESUS because there are those who will try and move us away from Him. Acts 20 teaches us that we need to look out for each other and ensure that we all find our refuge in Him. We need to continually read the Bible so

that we continue to transform so we become more and more like JESUS.

<sup>28</sup> So guard your hearts. Be true shepherds over all the flock and feed them well. Remember, it was the Holy Spirit who appointed you to guard and oversee the churches that belong to Jesus, the Anointed One, which he purchased and established by his own blood. <sup>29</sup> "I know that after I leave, imposters who have no loyalty to the flock will come among you like savage wolves. <sup>30</sup> Even some from among your very own ranks will rise up, twisting the truth to seduce people into following them instead of Jesus.

In the final chapter of the Bible at Revelation 22 we are told:

<sup>13</sup>"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the Completion." <sup>14</sup> Wonderfully blessed are those who wash their robes *white* so they can access the Tree of Life and enter the city *of bliss* by its *open* gates.

GOD invites us to trust Him for everything. Thank you, Gary for showing us how you have learnt to do this.




Another wonderful gathering of Cursillistas from all over our Diocese were in attendance.

With Assistant Bishop Sonia Roulston, we celebrated, yet another year of Christian community in Action in our Diocese.





