FROM OUR DIOCESAN SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR FR MARK COOPER



Christmas is almost upon us again. As we get older it is not unusual to feel time passing at what seems a faster speed. Not only this, but celebrations that used to fill us with joy and wonder can become routine, losing the sparkle from our youth. This sparkle can be re-invigorated when we see these celebrations anew through the eyes of our children, and in later years, our grandchildren.

Before Christmas arrives, we have the season of Advent, a time of preparation. Unfortunately, in our consumeristic society, by Advent our Christmas celebrations seem to be fully underway. Carols have already been playing in our shopping centres, decorations are on full display, and the first of the many Christmas parties have started.

I find it interesting how many people decry the increasing commercialisation of Christmas, and yet each year we all find ourselves getting caught up in the unavoidable. I don't say this to be an Ebenezer Scrooge about Christmas but more to ponder out loud, how we might find space for an Advent type preparation amidst the noise and bustle going on around us.

Firstly, we need to think about what Advent is preparing for. Advent has two goals, to prepare us to celebrate the season (12 days) of Christmas, and to prepare us for Jesus' second coming.

Preparation to celebrate the season of Christmas does mean engaging in the commercial side, buying presents, cards, and food. Getting our homes ready for family and friends. However we should also balance this with the knowledge that our time together is more important than how much we have spent.

Don't peak too soon. How often do we get to Christmas day and think "Thank God that's over for another year?" It is almost impossible to spend Advent in a time of fasting and prayer, but we can make conscious choices not to overindulge.

To prepare for Jesus' second coming we should be using Advent as a time of spiritual spring cleaning. What habits of faith have we let slip over the year? The first Sunday of Advent is the liturgical calendar's New Year's Day so starting afresh makes some sense.

When we get to Christmas Day, try to come to it with the wonder of a child. Listen to the Christmas story in the carols that we know by heart. Look deep into the manger scene at the Christ Child lying helplessly in the hay. Empathise with your parish clergy trying desperately to say something new and interesting for their umpteenth year.

Personally, when I look into the manger scene I can't help but hear Jesus words "Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it."



- Step 1: go to https:// www.cursillonewcastle.org.au/
- Step 2: Either at the top of the screen (or in The Menu, for smaller appliances) Click on "Forms"
- Scroll down until you get to M50 & W50 Dates & just below that you will see three (3) Downloads which will hopefully appear in blue type (unless you are still operating an Apple IIE Computer from 40 years ago)
- Double click on each blue download (one at a time – not all at once) & they should hopefully & miraculously appear in YOUR computer in 3 separate A4 Printout sheets

#### CURSILLO NATIONAL CONFERENCE, PERTH 2022

This was our first experience of a National gathering, so neither of us had any idea of what to expect.

What we experienced was a gathering of like-minded people from six dioceses who came together out of a desire to see Cursillo flourish. Those present were from Perth, Bunbury, Bathurst, Tasmania, South Queensland, and of course, Newcastle.

There were apologies from some who found the distance to Perth too great.

In some ways it was a typical Cursillo event with laughter, praise, singing, worship, meditations, rainbows, food and fellowship; intermingled with an AGM and discussions around the problems each diocese faces; and various suggested solutions, some of which have been trialled.

We were all reminded that Cursillo is not a static formula, it's a living movement; and we were encouraged to think how we might adapt it to our context and local needs. Apart from combined weekends and shortened weekends, some other ideas which have been explored are 'Taster Days' where the general Cursillo format is used to present a themed one-day workshop; and Fourth Day pilgrimages as palanca to areas that may be struggling.

Everyone agreed that the most effective aspects of Cursillo presentations are the personal stories and lived experiences.

While the conference was 'National,' Perth Secretariat was responsible for arranging the venue, catering and other 'nuts and bolts.' The program was set by National Secretariat and the National Spiritual Advisor was responsible for the roster for prayers, services, etc. The timing of the conference was set to coincide with the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations of Brisbane diocese taking Cursillo to Perth. On the Saturday evening, we attended the anniversary dinner at St Barnabas, Kalamunda and were made very welcome.

Three members of the original Brisbane team were present.
















The day finished with closing prayers, led by Bishop Sonia, and the singing of our Theme song "My Hope is Built on Nothing Less."
